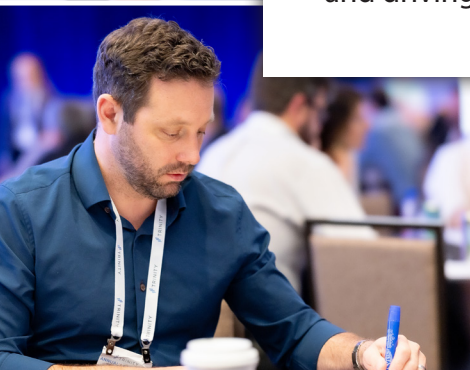

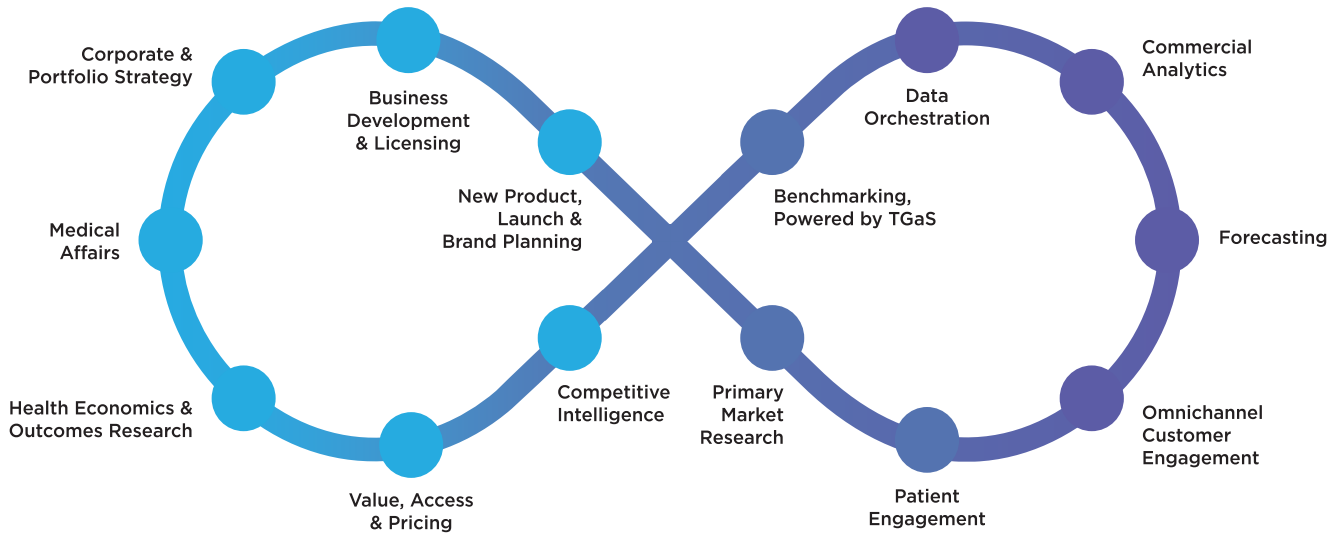

How is a typical project structured?



1. Flying Cover: 1-2 Leadership team members per project - Account Leader and/or Capability SME (PMR, RWE, COEs and EVAP)

2. Project Manager: Usually 1-2 Engagement Managers, Associate Principals - occasionally a Senior Consultant who is assigned a stretch opportunity

3. Project Staff: Usually 2-4 Associates, Consultants, Senior Consultants, depending on the capability area

What training opportunities does Trinity provide to staff?

At Trinity, we recognize that the first 3-6 months in a role has a big impact on long-term success, as a result we provide a wide-range of onboarding and ongoing trainings. Trinity has designed and implemented an intensive introductory training program for new hires. This program presents a comprehensive perspective on our vision and businesses, and trains individuals in specific analytical and technical skills necessary for success at Trinity. Throughout your tenure at Trinity, we continue to provide additional training to expand your professional skills and development. We offer a combination of trainings based upon the tenured knowledge from our leadership team, as well as professionally curated content from top industry experts through our partnership with LinkedIn Learning.

How much travel is required for consulting staff?

Trinity is unique to other consulting firms in that most of our client work is done in the office not offsite. Our consultants travel relative to their clients' needs and work, but in most cases these are short trips to clients. Therefore, Trinity maintains a unique environment that encourages employee-travel only when it is essential to the ongoing client relationship and as a result our offices are typically busy and collaborative.

What does Trinity do to help work-life balance?

We value a sensible balance between work and home life for our employees. We now operate on a hybrid work model where our staff is generally asked to work in-office 2 days per week. Other work-life balance benefits include Summer Fridays, unlimited vacation policy, company-wide holidays, and sabbatical leave programs.

How do I apply to Trinity? What does the interview process look like?

Please apply through both your e-recruiting system and through the link provided in the job description. Applicants who are selected will go through a series of behavioral and critical thinking/case interviews with members of our consulting staff. The First Round of interviews includes one, 45-minute behavioral/case interview. The Final Round of interviews include two, 45-minute behavioral/case interviews.

When does Trinity accept internship applications?

Resumes for internships are due first week in October. We also offer a PhD/PharmD/MD externship program in the Spring, applications are due in the late winter/early spring timeframe.
